

Book Study: Dear Church

Join us in reading and reflecting on the book, Dear Church: A Love Letter from A Black Preacher to the Whitest Denomination in the US, by Lenny Duncan. We will gather in four sessions, the first to give an overview of the book and co-create a covenant to guide how we will engage with each other, and the following three sessions to discuss each of the three parts of the book. We ask that those who decide to take part in this book study, to commit to attending all four sessions, and commit to reading the chosen section prior to attending so we can all engage in the discussion.


