

Ingathering Sundays – Feeding the Hungry

We continue our Ingathering tradition on the third Sunday of each month, but instead of canned and packaged food offerings, we invite our worshipers to make a virtual food offering online. TODAY, we invite you to make an Ingathering offering to Loaves & Fishes of Contra Costa, either through the DCC donations web page (select Outreach Donations / Other and type in "Loaves & Fishes") or directly to Loaves & Fishes.

Loaves and Fishes of Contra Costa is the largest provider of free hot meals to the hungry in Contra Costa County, serving over 138,000 hot meals last fiscal year in five dining rooms, including their newest one at Trinity Center in Walnut Creek. When COVID-19 came into our community, Loaves and Fishes did not miss a day of service! They had to close their dining rooms for sit-down meals but transitioned to a "to-go" style meal, experiencing a 50-60% increase in demand. And with the help of Carol Gilliland's catering company, *A Loveable Feast*, they have expanded their hot meal services to the weekends at their Pittsburg and Martinez locations.


Save the Date!
