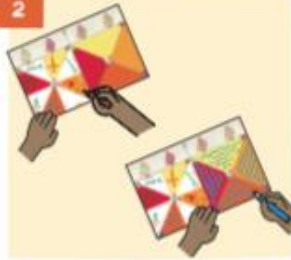
Holy Moly!

Illustrate each word. Decorate the other pinwheel pattern.

Cut at leaflet fold. Cut off gray strips. Carefully cut slits halfway toward center of squares.

Gently fold small purple corner triangle toward center. Place tape over center of pinwheel to hold in place.

5



Repeat with all corners of both pinwheels.

6



Punch hole in center of each pinwheel with a rounded toothpick.

Hold toothpicks vertically in fist with pinwheel resting horizontally on top. Blow to spin pinwheel around.

Celebrate Pentecost, the birthday of the church, with your pinwheels.
