



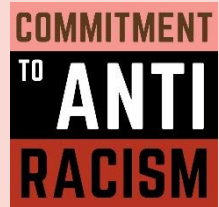
We will meet in Kairos Hall; childcare will be provided by teens in our youth group using the Agape Lounge and Dayspring playground.
